13. Repose or The British Lion by Géza Vastagh was used to sell products from which company? **Answer: Pears Soap**

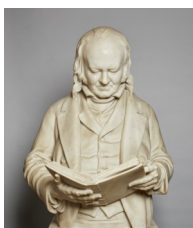


14. What is the title of this bronze by Louis-Ernest Barrias?

Answer: The First Funeral



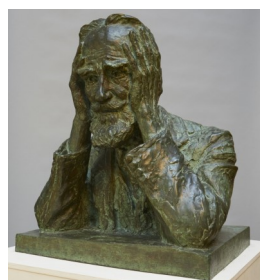
